

Alford Memorial Radio Club Sunday Night Net Preamble

Ask if the repeater is in use before proceeding. IDENTIFY EVERY 10 MINUTES.

“This is the Alford Memorial Radio Club Sunday night net. This net is called for the purpose of informing the general amateur radio community of the activities of the Alford Memorial Radio Club....to identify amateur radio activities in the Atlanta area that might be of interest to club members and to conduct a Buy, Sell, and Swap portion of the net. Everyone is welcome to check in. You do not have to be a member of the Alford Memorial Radio Club to participate.”

“This is <callsign>. My name is <name> and my QTH is <city/location> and I will be net control for tonight’s net.”

“At this time do we have any emergency traffic?” Pass the traffic if you get a response....otherwise announce: “Hearing none. Please remember, anyone with emergency traffic can break the net at anytime.”

“Do we have any priority or routine traffic for the net?” Acknowledge and handle.

Take mobile check-ins.

Take short-time check-ins.

Take Echolink check-ins.

Take Club Officers and Committee Chairpersons.

Take any station with an announcement or Buy, Sell, or Swap items.

Take all other check-ins and if you have any announcements you would like to make, sprinkle them in during down times.

Make a last call for check-ins. If none heard announce: “Hearing no further check-ins, this will conclude tonight’s net. I would like to thank all who participated. We had ____ check-ins for tonight’s net. This is <callsign> closing the net at <time> local and returning the repeater back to normal operations.
